United Auto Workers Strike Continues into Week Two



WORK STOPPAGE



In its first strike against GM in 12 years, nearly 50,000 UAW members stopped work at more than 50 sites including parts distribution centers and assembly, stamping, propulsion, component, and battery plants.



As the strike enters week two, negotiations continue with no final resolution announced.

FLEET IMPACT



GM vehicles built in plants located in the United States are affected.



GM is averaging several weeks of dealer inventory depending on model.



Extent of impact on vehicle deliveries still unknown at this time.

FORECAST & FLEET MEASURES



Length of strike may be impacted by UAW membership ratification of agreements prior to resuming work.
